On the occasion of this anniversary event the two central events, the GAT (gas industry convention) and the WAT (water industry convention) are uniquely joined together. The conference, where up to 6,000 participants are expected, takes place right in the middle of the exhibition, where about 300 german companies will present their solutions towards an outstanding water supply and a secure gas supply.

HOW TO GET THERE:

Travelling by car:

Please follow the signs in and around Leipzig that excellently point the way to both Leipzig exhibition grounds and the abundant parking facilities.

Travelling by train or air:

Tram no. 16 towards "Messegelände" (final stop) will take you from the centrally located central railway station to the exhibition grounds in 19 minutes. Trams leave every 8 minutes and stop almost in front of the exhibition entrance (Messeeingang West, Glashalle / glass building).

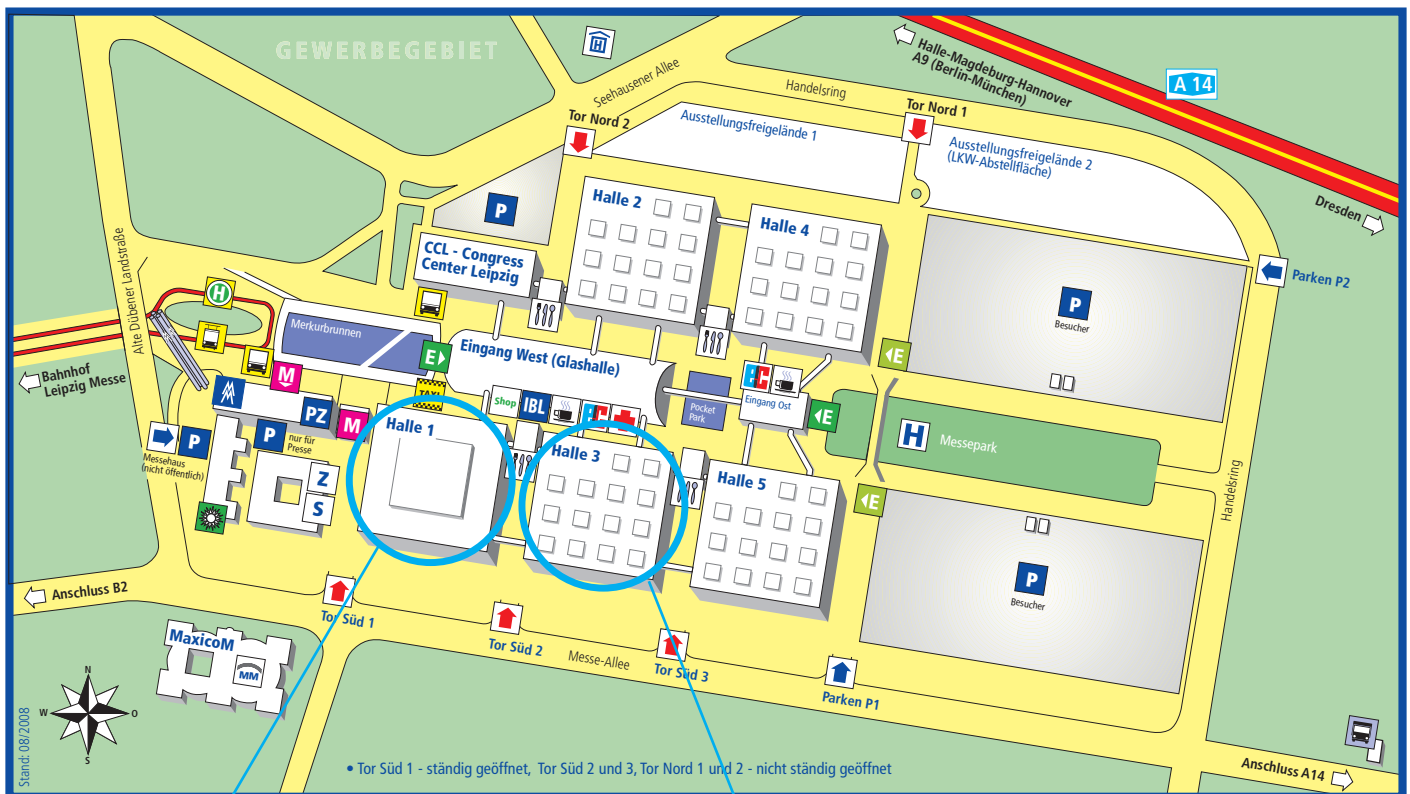
Regional trains (RB) depart every 30 minutes from Leipzig central station to the exhibition grounds. Travelling time between central station and "Leipzig – Neue Messe" station: 6 minutes.

The "FlughafenExpress" (RE) service connecting Halle/Leipzig Airport and Leipzig central station runs every 30 minutes, calling also at "Leipzig – Neue Messe" station. It will take you to the exhibition station safely and quickly from either the airport or the central station in 8 or 6 minutes, respectively.

A 10-minute-walk will take you from the exhibition station (Messebahnhof) to Messeeingang West (Glashalle/glass building), or Exit tram no. 16 at the next and final station, "Messegelände".

Taxis can be found in front of Terminal B at the airport or in the city in front of the centrally located central station. Traffic permitting, the ride between the exhibition grounds and the airport/city is 15 minutes approx.
